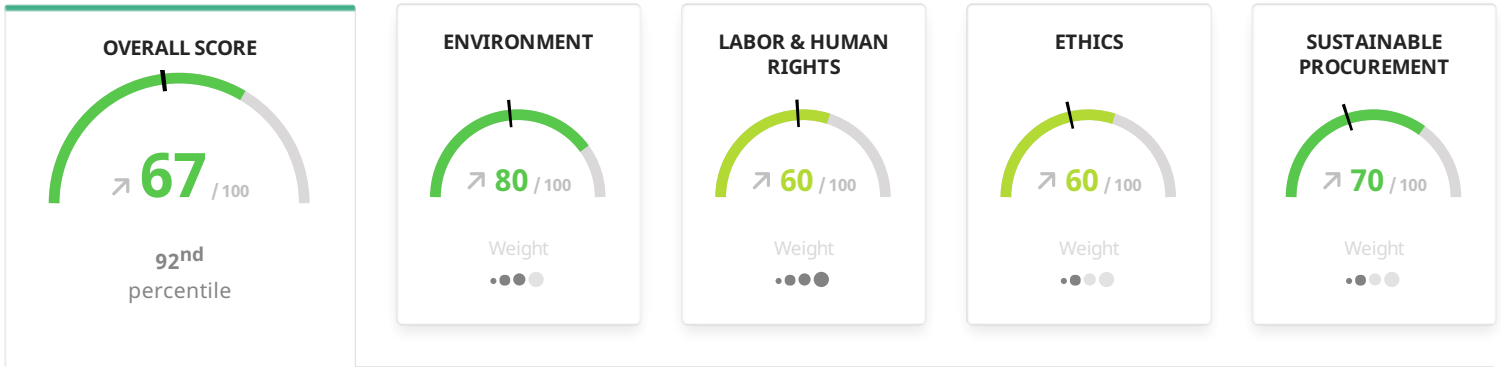

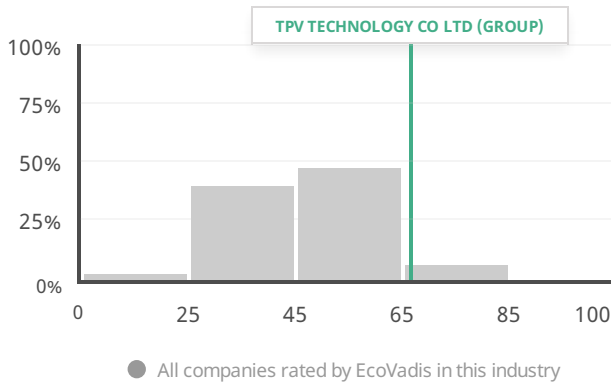

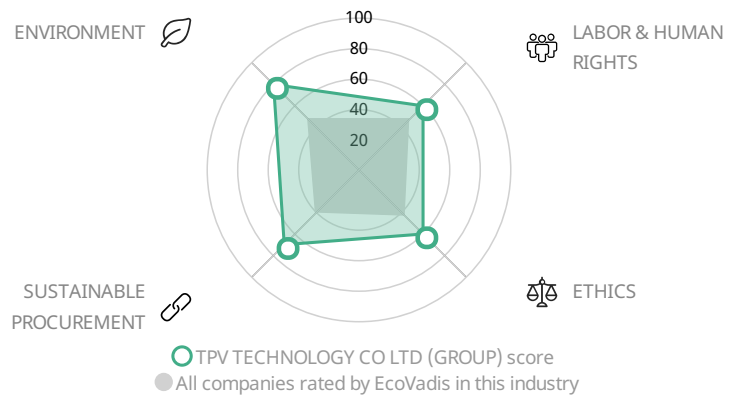

At 3:30 on March 4, 2020, in the No. 8 workshop of Three Titans Technology, Hu, a molder in the molding technology class, transported the mold from the No. 6 workshop to the mold protection area of No. 8 workshop to carry out the mold homing operation. Hu used No. 07 bridge crane to lift the mold from the electric rail car and hoisted and transferred to the manual rail car. Hu hand-pushed the rail car to carry the mold to the No. 09 crane hoisting area. At 3:48:18, Hu finished tying the crane hooks, slings and mold rings, and started to operate the crane on the east side of the mold (where the incident occurred) to tighten the slings. At 3:48:48, the mold fell over, and Hu XX was unable to retreat in time, and was pressed by the mold to the mold behind him which squeezed his chest and neck to death
