Issues to be resolved

- The meeting room is quite large, and the current projector screen isn't sufficient to be visible to everyone in the room.
- Installing a larger screen for each person isn't feasible, as it could obstruct others' views.
- The room is equipped with a single main PC for presentations, and the monitors must be connected via HDMI or mini-HDMI to accommodate the splitter.
- Additionally, there is a need for adjustable angles to cater to individual viewing preferences.
